Dear Mr. Sprague:-

In reply to your favor of the 18th. will say, I regret that the new scale for our local is not as yet quite complete.

I expect at the next regular meeting Sept. 5. the orchestra list will be adopted and the band scale proposed.

The theatre scale beginning labor day has been adopted and unless a reconsideration is made it is to be \$40.00 for men and \$50.00 for leader per week of 6 days.

Among some of the changes for orch. work we are to get \$5.00 for dancing 8 to 12 and \$1.50 per hour for over time, weddings and receptions not over 4 hours \$6.00 banquets not over 1 1/2 hours \$4.00 number of men in small halls and private dwellings not less than four with piano or six without piano, for dancing in small halls we do not have a limit as to number of men.

When the list is completed I will be very glad to mail one to you in near time if you desire any information I will be pleased to get same for you, hoping that your local will be a success in every way. I remain,
